Created by European Schoolnet, the Future Classroom Lab (FCL) is an inspirational learning environment in Brussels, challenging visitors to rethink the role of pedagogy, technology and design in their classrooms. Through six learning zones, visitors can explore the essential elements in delivering 21st century learning: students' and teachers' skills and roles, learning styles, learning environment design, current and emerging technology, and societal trends affecting education. The Future Classroom Lab also has inspired schools and other organisations to create their own learning labs.

During the Open Day, the Flemish schools have the opportunity to visit the Future Classroom Lab, learn about the learning zones and technology, and get ideas how to implement a learning lab or flexible learning environments in their schools. Please note both English and Dutch are used. Lunch and coffee are provided.

Registration is required because places are limited. Schools can book up to three places, but if places are available, more people from the school can join.
