

LSL Showcase, Demonstrate, Validate

Showcase-Demonstrate-Validate is one of the central aims of the project and is embedded in the school STEPS plan (Share, Teach, Evidence, Plan, Support):

- Showcasing: where you share/‘showcase’ existing practice, something you already know. Often this is linked to showing something unique about your school/classroom.
- Demonstrating: examples of innovative practice you ‘demonstrate’ to others in the LSL network, showing how they can be mainstreamed and replicated across other schools. This is something for others, so that they can follow your example of innovative practice.
- Validating: areas of innovation and change you are currently working on/trialling in your school. It is something that you are not ready to showcase or demonstrate to others. For Advanced School, this might be captured in your individual STEPS plan, but it may only apply to certain individuals and does not necessarily involve the whole staff.
