Main evaluation findings

The information presented in this document is based on **course registration and participation** (started/completed) data*, and on the data collected via 2 surveys completed voluntarily <u>before</u> (pre) and <u>after</u> (post) the course, providing information about:

- > the **profile** of course participants (Slides 3-7).
- > the participants' course impressions (Slide 8-10).
- > participants' self-assessed knowledge of course topics (Slide 11).

On Slide 2 we offer an overview of the key results.

Based on: registration and participation data, pre: 564 responses and post: 388 responses.

Main audiences:

The course is targeted primarily to secondary school teachers and school leaders.

Modules: 4

- According to data collected via the pre-course survey, the majority of course participants are secondary school teachers, female and 36 years old or older.
- > All 98% rated the overall value of the course as "Good" or "Very good".
- ➤ All **91%** would recommend this course to a colleague (Agree or Agree strongly).
- All **94%** Agreed that they will use the ideas and examples presented in the course.

Basic numbers

3158 people from 72 countries registered to take part in the MOOC

1914 participants started following at least one course module

687 participants who completed the MOOC*

61% engagement rate**

36% completion rate***

^{*} The participant is counted as a completer if the participant has explored all the sections of the MOOC and did all the activities.

^{**} The <u>course engagement rate</u> is calculated by dividing the number of participants who explored at least one section of the course by the total number of participants who registered to the course.

^{***} The <u>course completion rate</u> is calculated by dividing the total number of participants who explored at least one section of the MOOC) by the total number of participants that completed the course (by exploring all the sections of the course).











- > 36 years of age or older.


How old are you?








What are your main motivations for joining this EUN Academy course? (more than one answer possible)






Course impressions







98% of post-survey respondents rated the overall value of the course as "Good" or "Very good"




Course impressions and impact

To what extent do you agree with the following statements since you completed the course?






Pre-to-post change in self-assessed competence in the course topic

Which statement below best represents your level of competence in using resources and strategies for applying active learning (student centered pedagogies) in the classroom






Practice peer assessment




- Participants' view of the practice peer assessment was overall positive.

■ Strongly agree ■ Agree ■ Neither disagree nor agree ■ Disagree ■ Strongly disagree




Practice peer assessment



Participants' who completed the practice peer assessment felt slightly more prepared for the final activity and found it more useful compared to those who haven't completed it.


Evaluation of the final activity (Strongly agree + Agree)
